PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND COMPLAINT

COMES NOW plaintiff, John B. Thompson, hereinafter Thompson, as a citizen and as an attorney on his own behalf, and moves this court for leave to amend again his complaint herein, stating:

1. Since filing the original and amended complaint herein, circumstances have unfortunately changed. The Florida Supreme Court has denied Thompson any state remedy for the excesses of The Florida Bar. Additionally, this week, a video game web site, citing the need for The Florida Bar to end Thompson's legal career, has threatened him with physical violence, stating "Jack Thompson should be shot," etc.

2. Just today, we have received word from The Florida Bar as to new outrageous antics by it that even we can't believe. They give rise to new causes of action.

3. Thompson apologizes to the court for amending his complaint herein for the second time without leave of court. His law practice over three decades has been almost exclusively in state court and almost always on the defense side. He was unaware of the requirements of the Federal Rules in this regard, which of course is no excuse, but instead an explanation.

4. Thompson seeks to amend his complaint so that the entire fact situation giving rise to what he believes are his legal remedies might be addressed in one action, given what he believes is the comprehensive nature of the collaborated assault upon him, his law license, and his very safety.

5. Thompson has not attached the proposed amended complaint because this situation, unfortunately, is very fluid, having changed even today, in that yet another Internet site has apparently published Thompson's phone numbers and home address to encourage harassment of him in coordination with what the other defendants are doing. In addition, word of The Bar's latest stunt was received just today. Thus, the proposed amended complaint will look a great deal like the Third Amended Complaint, with one or more additional defendants and causes of action, but all of it relating to civil rights violations, etc., by the various defendants.

WHEREFORE, Thompson respectfully moves this court for leave to amend the complaint herein.
